

Horse Pulling Contest

Saturday, October 7, 2023 – Equine Arena
 Lightweight: 7:30 PM -- Heavyweight: 8:30 PM

1. There will be two classes – Lightweight for teams weighing 3,425 pounds and under; Heavyweight for teams weighing more than 3,425 pounds.
2. Entries close September 30, 2023. Additional teams will be accepted after September 30, 2023 if space allows.
3. The entry fee is \$50 per team for each team entered prior to September 30, 2023. If space allows teams will be accepted after September 30, 2023, at a rate of \$150 per team. Payment must accompany the entry. Stalls can be purchased for \$50 per stall or exhibitors may work off their trailer. **PLEASE NOTE: ***ALL EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO PAY A \$5 PENNSYLVANIA LIVESTOCK ASSOCIATION ADMINISTRATION FEE TO COMPETE AT KILE.*****
4. STALL AVAILABILITY – See [Horse – General & Health Rules](#) for Arrival times & Barns Open times. **No animals may be unloaded between 11:00 PM and 6:00 AM. DO NOT REMOVE PANELS FROM ANY STALL!** Exhibitors will be charged \$50 per panel for all panels removed without permission. Contact the Horse Show office if you need panels removed.
5. Exhibitors with teams of questionable weight should make but one entry per team. The official weighing with halters on will determine the class in which the team is eligible to pull. Teams will be weighed from 3:00-5:00 PM the day of the contest. A mandatory driver meeting will be held prior to the pull at 5:30 PM.
6. Horses may pull in one class only and only one division.
7. A sled will be used in the contest.
8. The contest will start at approximately 7:30 PM, Saturday. Lightweight and Heavyweight teams will pull together but will place as separate classes.
9. The contest will be conducted under KILE rules. Detailed rules will be furnished to each entry. Competition is limited to teams owned by contestants residing in North America.
10. Entries – The contest is limited to a total of 40 teams. Entries must be made in the proper class. The first 20 Lightweight and the first 20 Heavyweight entries will be accepted based upon date and time of postmark. If one class fails to reach a total of 20 entries then additional entries will be accepted in the other class up to the total of 40 teams.
11. Stabling – Teams must use their assigned stall, if purchased.
12. OUTSTANDING ACCOUNTS – If monies are owed to the show for any reason, the premium checks will be held and exhibitors will not be allowed to participate in any Commonwealth-sponsored show until restitution is made for the outstanding accounts.
13. Regardless of the number of teams entered, 100% of the class premiums will be paid out. If less than 10 teams compete, remaining premiums will be distributed to eligible entries as determined by the show committee and management.
