SPECIAL RULES FOR SALE CLASSES

1. ELIGIBILITY –

- a. All animals must meet the health rules as printed in [Sheep – Open Breeding](#).
- b. All ewes entered in the sale must show in their respective classes: Border Leicester – 13, 17, 20; Cheviot – 53, 57, 60; Columbia – 93, 97, 100; Corriedale – 133, 137, 140; Dorper – 173, 177, 180; Dorset – 213, 217, 220; Horned Dorset – 253, 257, 260; Hampshire – 293, 297, 330; Merino – 333, 337, 340; Montadale – 373, 377, 380; Natural Colored – 413, 417, 420; Oxford – 453, 457, 460; Rambouillet – 493, 497, 500; Lincoln – 533, 537, 540; Shropshire – 573, 577, 580; Southdown – 613, 617, 620; Suffolk – 653, 657, 660; Tunis – 693, 697, 700; Weather Dams – 733, 737, 740; Katahdin - 773, 777, 780. They may also show in group and champion classes.
- c. All ewes shown must sell unless eliminated due to quality or health reasons. The judge will be asked to eliminate sheep that he/she feels are not of sufficient quality to sell. The show veterinarian may also recommend withdrawal for health reasons.
- d. All yearling ewes, except those Dorsets that have lambs at side, will be sold as exposed. The consignor may elect to guarantee her/his ewe as bred at time of sale. If announced, this guarantee is made by the consignor and settlement must be made between her/him and the purchaser. The Exposition or Sale Manager will not accept responsibility in the guarantee.
- e. HAMPSHIRE ONLY – The Hampshire Sale Committee will individually inspect and approve each animal to be offered in the sale from a standpoint of soundness, proper breed type, and purity.
- f. SOUTHDOWN ONLY – All sheep must be sheared one week before showing.
- g. SHROPSHIRE ONLY – All Shropshire breeding sheep must be shorn completely to the hide within five days of the show date. The wool may be left from the rear hocks down and the front knees down plus the wool cap defined from the ears and poll forward.
- h. MONTADALE ONLY – No artificial coloring may be used.

2. ENTRIES –

- a. Entries must be made on a Keystone International Livestock Exposition entry blank. Contact the sale manager or KILE office for entry blanks. **MAIL ENTRIES TO THE SALE MANAGER ONLY.**
- b. Must include (1) pedigree, (2) name and association number of ram to which ewe was bred or exposed, (3) date of breeding or period exposed to ram.
- c. Postmark of August 31, 2021, is the deadline for entries.
- d. A sale charge of 10 percent will be made on all sheep sold.
- e. Substitution within reason or that which improves the quality of the sheep offered for sale will be accepted.

3. **ENTRY FEE** – \$20 per head entry that will enter the ewe in both the sale and the KEYSTONE INTERNATIONAL LIVESTOCK EXPOSITION. The Sale Manager will make entry and pay entry fees for all sheep to the Exposition. DO NOT MAKE SEPARATE ENTRY TO THE EXPOSITION. There will be no refund. **Checks made payable to: KILE.**
4. **ENTRY LIMIT** – The first 25 entries per breed received will be accepted with the earliest postmark date as priority.
5. **AWARDS** –
 - a. The Keystone International Livestock Exposition will present a special award to each of the Champion Sale Ewes.
 - b. The Pennsylvania Suffolk Sheep Association will present a special plaque to the Reserve Champion Sale Ewe.
 - c. The Pennsylvania-Maryland Shropshire Breeder's Association will present a special award to the Reserve Champion Sale Ewe.
6. Animals purchased (except Weather Dams) are eligible to be shown in the KILE Junior Sheep Breeding Show Sunday, October 10, 2021. Junior exhibitors entering purchased Keystone Bred Ewe Spectacular sheep must register them with the sheep show committee no later than 7:00 PM Saturday, October 9, 2021, and pay a \$5.00 per head entry fee. All other KILE rules apply.
